**Cost:**

Panning for Gemstones:	\$ 4.50
Hawk Mountain Sanctuary:	\$ 4.00 (Ages 6-12: \$2.40) - group rates

**Fuel Calculation:**

Friday Mileage: 88.52 miles  
Saturday Mileage: 63.08 miles  
Sunday Mileage: 115.16 miles  
266.76 miles, rounded down to 250 miles

Per Vehicle: Avg. 15 mpg = 16.66 gallons/fuel x \$3.20/gal. =  
\$53.33/veh. x 4 vehicles = \$213.33
