- Class "A" uniform for Jamboree Show on Saturday and Sunday Mass.
- Red Class "B" Troop shirts,
- Jamboree Class "B" Shirt.
- Scout socks (multiple pairs)
- 1 Pair of Comfortable Shoes (2 pairs are better)
- Two or more scout pants or green colored scout shorts.
- 1 Scout Book
- 1 Belt
- 5 Underwear
- Cool hat to provide shade from the sun.
- Rain Jacket/Poncho
- Sun Block
- Insect repellent
- 1 Toothpaste & brush
- 1 Deodorant
- 1 Comb or brush

Last Minute Reminders

- Do not forget your new Jamboree shirt.

- Our return trip is planned to arrive back to the Church parking lot on Sunday, August 1, 2010 between 1PM and 3PM. We will call parents on the trip home to notify the actual time.

Security (Important)

- Due to increased security at the Jamboree, all Scouts and adults are asked to bring a photo ID.

Health & Personal Care

- The jamboree can be a miserable experience for anyone with **sore or injured feet**. New shoes that are not broken in; shoes that fit too tightly or have wrinkled linings; and socks that are too tight, wrinkled, have holes, or are unclean should not be worn.
- Wear headgear and use a **sunscreen lotion** with a sun protection factor rating of SPF 30 or more on the face, ears, nose, knees, and backs of knees. Apply sunscreen two or three times a day.
- Scouts and adults must drink a **large amount of water** during the jamboree because of the heat, humidity, and physical exertion. This is very important in combating heat exhaustion or possible heat stroke. It is particularly important that each person carry water during the day and to the arena on show nights. Availability of water at the arena site is very limited.
- Note: Any **medical problem** MUST be reported to one of the adult leaders.
