Adult and Parental Permission to Use Personal Information on Web site

Boy Scout Troop 103 is requesting permission to display a limited amount of personal information about adult leaders on the Boy Scout Troop 103's web site. Additionally, we are asking parents to authorize permission to display photographs of your youth scout at scouting events or activities on the web site. It is our policy not to display names of scouts or youth under the age of 18 unless requested by the parent or guardian.

Personal Safety

While most Internet users are honest, there is a criminal element that seeks information as a way to gain access to victims. For that reason, we are especially careful about not providing any personal information—names, e-mail addresses, phone numbers, etc., of any youth on our web site. The Troop will always get written permission before posting personal information about adult volunteers, and never publish personal information about youth members.

Authorization Forms

The top form "For Adults" will provide us permission to include photographs of parents that may be taken at various scouting events. Please check the appropriate boxes. Names, Phone numbers, email addresses are normally displayed only for a select few Adult Leaders.

The form "For Children" will allow us to include photographs with out names on the gallery section and other sections of the web site.

For parents of scouts, please complete both forms and return them to me. If completing both forms, do not forget to sign both.
